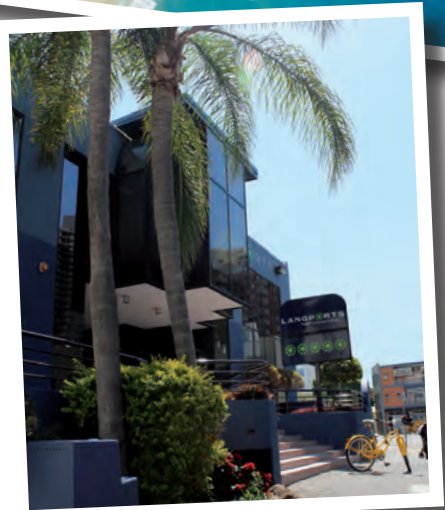
GOLD COAST

THE ACCOMMODATION

- All students stay with a host family, appointed by Langports staff
- No more than one student per family speaking the same language (unless requested)
- Langports provides orientation for students on how to live in an Australian home
